# HEARING LOSS SERVICES

**INFORMATION** 

Approximately 2/3 of Americans over age 70 have hearing loss but only 20% of seniors who need hearing aids actually purchase them. Depending on the type and extent of hearing loss, there are many options available for help.

Signs of hearing loss may include (seniors should contact their doctor if they have more than a couple of these signs):

- ◆Trouble hearing over the telephone
- ♦Difficulty understanding others unless face to face
- Need to turn up TV or radio so loud that others complain
- Having a problem hearing because of background noise
- •Sensing that others seem to mumble
- ♦Hearing a ringing, roaring or hissing sound frequently
- ♦Constantly asking for others to repeat themselves
- ♦Making inappropriate responses to questions
- ♦Straining to hear
- Missing essential sounds like doorbells, alarm clocks or smoke alarms.

Seniors enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan will have a Plan member card in addition to their red, white and blue Medicare card. If seeing a new physician or other health care provider, seniors should call the customer service number on their Plan card to make sure the provider and procedure are approved for payments by their Plan. Seniors in traditional Medicare will have only the Medicare card and should <u>always ask in advance</u> whether it will be accepted as payment when scheduling an appointment, at check-in for an unscheduled/urgent care/hospital visit or when purchasing supplies/prescribed drugs or other items. Also, some providers do not accept Medicare assignment, which results in seniors paying more for their visits/supplies so this should be clarified prior to scheduling services.
