Create in clay sculptural hand built functional objects.

**Choose one (afternoon or early evening), TSC Clay Studio**  
**Wednesdays, Feb. 5 - 26, 1:30 – 4:30 p.m., OR Wednesdays, Feb. 5 -26, 6 – 8:30 p.m.** Slow down to explore your surroundings as you 'tangle' (create patterns) with ink, graphite, color on round white paper Zendalas. Guided by introduction to Zentangle and its core 8-steps, slow down to enjoy expressing the four seasons, the 12 months, a mini labyrinth, cartouche. For all levels. \$40(Seniors 50+) \$48(others)

**Zentangle® 4 Weeks, Styles of Patterns from the Past, Part 1 Midori Okasako, CZT.** Choose one (afternoon or early evening), TSC Clay Studio Wednesdays, March 4 - 25, 1:30 – 4:30 p.m., OR Wednesdays, March 4 - 25, 6 – 8:30 p.m.  
Journey back in time and visit a variety of cultures, as you create beautiful 'tangles' (patterns) with Chiaroscuro (light & shade) with black & brown inks, graphite, white charcoal on 'threaded' and 'woven' white/ toned paper tiles. Slowly guided by core Zentangle 8-steps, unplug yourself to be inspired by everlasting universal, ornamental expressions.
