## SUMMARY OF OFFENSES AND PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

On June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at approximately 5:03 PM, Officers of the Tallahassee Police Department responded to 2731 Blair Stone Road, apartment 40, in reference to a missing person. Victoria Sims, a 74-year-old female who resided alone at the apartment, had not been seen since the afternoon of June 11<sup>th</sup>. A family friend had gone to the residence to check on Sims' welfare. The front door was found ajar and the condition of the interior of the residence indicated that a burglary may have occurred. It was also discovered that Sims' vehicle, a white colored Toyota sedan, bearing Florida registration IGDV12, was missing.

The Court authorized a warrant compelling Sims' cellular service to provide current geo-location data for her cellular telephone. It was determined that Sims' cellular telephone was located within in the immediate area of the residence located at 2110 Monday Road.

The resident of 2110 Monday Road was identified as Aaron Glee via law enforcement records.

While speaking with Sims' family members, investigators developed a list of her friends and associates. A male subject, known only as "Aaron" who lived on Monday Road, had been identified as one of those associates. Investigators were told that Sims often prepared meals for "Aaron" and delivered them to his residence. It was reported that "Aaron", who did not own his own vehicle, often obtained transportation from Sims.

Officers and investigators traveled to 2110 Monday Road in attempt to locate Sims. Upon arrival, Sims' Toyota was observed on the northeast side of the residence. It was mired in mud and was immobile. A sheet had been placed over the rear of the Toyota and the license plate was bent upwards, concealing the registration's characters and numerals. There were also indications that an attempt had been made to drive the Toyota deeper into the heavily wooded area on the northeast side of the residence.

Officers attempted contact at the front door of the residence, but received no response. Based upon the totality of all of the information known, there was concern that Sims was inside of the residence, either injured or being held against her will. Officers breached the front door and entered into the residence.

The body of a deceased female, later positively identified as Sims, was found inside of the northwestern bedroom. Sims was positioned on the carpeted floor in a partially prone position. Her arms and feet had been bound behind her in a particular manner. It would be determined that Sims was the victim of murder.

Glee was not found inside of the residence. Officers searched the surrounding wooded area in hopes of locating him. While searching a heavily wooded parcel of property that was adjacent to Glee's residence, officers located the remains of second deceased female, later positively identified as Oluwatoyin Ruth Salau – age nineteen.

The area where Salau's body was located was approximately two hundred and fifty-feet northeast of Glee's residence. A path led from the residence to the general area where Salau was discovered. Salau's body was found to have been purposely covered with leaves and other vegetation. It would be determined that Salau was the victim of murder.

In regard to Salau;

In the early morning hours of June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Salau had contacted the Tallahassee Police Department 119.011(2)(h)

It is noted here that the investigation into that incident has revealed that the battery suspect had no involvement in Salau's murder.

On June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Salau's mother contacted the Tallahassee Police Department to report that she had not seen her daughter in forty-eight hours. Initial investigative steps were taken, and the following day investigators made contact with Salau's mother, entered Salau into NCIC/FCIC as a missing person, and issued a press release. Investigators began making contact with Salau's friends and associates. Despite all efforts, investigators could only determine Salau's movements up until the late afternoon hours of June 6<sup>th</sup>. It was found that she had visited a public library in the 2800 block of South Adams Street. While there she had inquired about shelter type programs for displaced women and then placed a nineteen-minute telephone call to a local women's shelter. Library staff advised that Salau left the library at approximately 5:20 PM. Suspecting that Salau may have sought services at that particular women's shelter, Investigators made several inquiries. Citing client confidentiality, that particular women's shelter declined to provide any information regarding Salau.

It is noted that body camera footage captured during Salau's contact with officers in the early morning hours of June 6<sup>th</sup>, demonstrated that she had been wearing a black colored tee shirt,

black shorts with a distinctive light-colored pattern, and white colored rubberized Croc style shoes at the time.

The Court authorized warrants for the search of Glee's 2110 Monday Road residence, and of the adjacent parcel of property where Salau's body was discovered. Inside of the residence, investigators located a black colored tee shirt, black shorts with a distinctive light-colored pattern, and white colored Croc style shoes -all of which Salau was known to have been wearing on June 6<sup>th</sup>.

It was determined that approximately two hours prior to the discovery of the bodies of Sims and Salau, at approximately 3:48 PM, Glee purchased a bus ticket at Greyhound Bus Lines, 112 West Tennessee Street. His bus departed Tallahassee at approximately 5:45 PM bound for West Palm Beach. On June 14<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 12:30 AM, Glee was detained at a Greyhound bus terminal by the Orlando Police Department. After complaining of difficulty breathing, he was transported to an Orlando hospital for evaluation.

Arrest warrants for the murder of Sims were authorized within hours of his detention.

Video footage captured by Tal-Tran demonstrated that Salau had left the area of the South Adams Street library by bus at approximately 5:51 PM. She arrived at the bus stop in the 3500 block of Apalachee Parkway at approximately 6:07 PM. That footage also demonstrated that she and Glee did engage in an extended conversation while seated on a bench at the bus stop. At approximately 7:07 PM, a white Toyota, the same make and model of the one owned by Sims, arrived in the area of the bus stop. Glee and Salau departed in that Toyota moments later.



This footage also demonstrated that Salau was clad in a black colored tee shirt, black shorts with a distinctive light-colored pattern, and white colored Croc style shoes. As previously noted, these clothing items were found within Glee's residence.



Based upon the information known, your Affiant has cause to believe that beginning on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Aaron Glee did forcibly, secretly, or by threat confine, abduct, or imprison another person, Oluwatoyin Ruth Salau, against her will and without lawful authority with the intent to inflict bodily harm upon or to terrorize the other person, contrary to Section 787.01(1)(a)3, Florida Statutes.

Your Affiant also has cause to believe that on an undetermined date between June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and approximately June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Aaron Glee did unlawfully kill a human being, Oluwatoyin Ruth Salau, 119.011(2)(h)

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

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
